

# AUDITORIUM UPDATE

## Fall 2014

We are so excited to be back in the auditorium! Phase One of our renovations is complete. We have new flooring, seating, wall surfaces, and a fresh coat of paint on everything. Thank you so much for giving towards this project and for being flexible during the month of August while the work was being done.

The next phase for renovation in this space involves new lighting for both the seating areas and the stage. Currently, we are working with a hodgepodge of lighting equipment: some of it original to the building and other parts we have added in recent years. This lighting update would include new fixtures and a new control system. Additionally, all of the wiring and electrical infrastructure would be brought up to current electrical building codes. All of this would greatly increase the brightness of the room. The lighting cost is close to \$100,000.
